He was married at Heyworth, McLean County, Illinois, to PAULINE CLARK who was born October 18——, on a farm near Randolph, McLean County, Illinois; the daughter of Harrison H. Clark and Sarah Maria Blandin. She died April, 1907, at Greeley, Weld County, Colorado, and is buried in the Heyworth cemetery, at Heyworth, Illinois; her father was born July 6, 1836, in Knox County, Ohio. Charles Edwin Greenlee went into business at Heyworth, Illinois, in 1894, with his brother, John D. Greenlee.
