On August 4, 1868, at Elwood, Madison County, Indiana, he was married to MARY MAGDALENA KEATON who was born at Falmouth, Rush County, Indiana, on July 23, 1849, the daughter of Ambrose R. Keaton and Emily Blue. Emily Blue was born January 30, 1825; died March 25, 1894, the daughter of James and Mary Blue.
