son of Elizabeth Greenlee Van Bibber and Richard Tillis, was born June 1, 1845, in Mason County, West Virginia; died November 9, 1918 and is buried in the New Antioch cemetery, near Red House, West Virginia. In July, 1864, he was married to JANE ANN McCOY who was born April 30, 1845, in Mason County, West Virginia; died September 6, 1891, and is buried in the Forest Hill cemetery, in Mason County, West Virginia; she was the daughter of David McCoy and Elizabeth Hatfield. Elizabeth Hatfield died at the birth of her daughter, Jane Ann. On August 5, 1897, in Mason County, West Virginia, Smith Tillis was married to Mrs. Mary A. D.
