

Review, and then to Louisville, Kentucky, where he was discharged, then to Davenport Iowa, where he was mustered out. He returned to his home August 10, 1865, having served in the army three years and nine months. He completed his course of medicine, graduating from the Keokuk College of Medicine, at Keokuk, Iowa, June 9, 1875, and then became actively engaged in the practice of medicine and surgery. During President Cleveland's first administration he was appointed postmaster at Weldon, Iowa; and under his second administration was a member of the examining board of surgeons for the Bureau of Pensions. He was the examining physician for four life insurance companies; a member of the school board four times, three of which he was its president. He practiced medicine in Corydon, Iowa; Weldon, Iowa, and finally located in Humeston, Iowa. He was W. M. of the Masonic lodge at that place; was clerk of the first Baptist Church and superintendent of the Sunday School for a number of years. He was a Democrat.
